Sreenivasa Rao, Principal**, and NJK Narendra Kumar, Vice Principal, who appreciated the efforts of the Women Empowerment Cell and the Eluru District Police in spreading awareness. They advised students to stay informed and practice cyber safety in their daily lives.


The session was interactive, with students engaging in discussions and raising queries related to cyber security.

Faculty Participation in ToT Program and Workshop on Child-Centric Disaster Risk Reduction







Faculty attended BOS as Subject Expert at ANR Degree College, NTR District




