Awareness on Ban on Single Use Plastics





What is single-use plastic? Single-use plastics, or disposable plastics, are used only once before they are thrown away or recycled. These items are things like plastic bags, straws, coffee stimers, soda and water bodies, and most food packaging. We produce roughly 300 million tons of plastic each year and half of it is disposable! World-wide only 10-13% of plastic items are recycled.



On March 15, 2025, the Department of Botany organized an awareness program on banning single-use plastics as part of the *Swacha Andhra-Swarna Andhra (SASA) initiative*, following directives from the Government of Andhra Pradesh and DCE, Mangalagiri. The event featured a lecture by V. Madan Mohan Rao, Incharge of the Department, highlighting the environmental hazards of plastic waste, followed by a live demonstration on eco-friendly alternatives in collaboration with other departments and the SASA committee. The campaign effectively raised awareness among students, faculty, and staff, significantly reducing plastic use on campus. 
Faculty Participation in National Seminar at ANU, Guntur
