Each mentor was assigned about 15 students who closely monitored the work in progress and submitted the same to the Principal's Desk on a weekly basis. The Principal, in turn, consolidated the entire process of the Community Service Project CSP) carried out in the College At large and tabled the same on to the A.P.C.C.E.'s Desk on a fortnightly basis.

The topics of interest include: Living Conditions of Daily Wage Laborers, The Plight of Leased Poultry Farmers, Health and Hygiene, English for Competitive Exams, Animal Population, and so on..
